

## **LESC 2021 Covid - 19 Operating Procedures as club reopens level 3**

**The following procedures may change as Scottish guidelines & restrictions alter. LESC will continue to follow these guidelines along with the RYA guidance on returning to boating.**

**Each week a register will be posted on the outside of the red hatch at the club kitchen. Everyone visiting the club shall add their names to the list and the dates they intend to be staying.**

**No requirement for contact details, in the result of a Covid outbreak the contact details will be given from the membership database.**

**A new list will go up each week this is a Scottish gov. requirement for us to open.**

**If you are unwell with the symptoms of Covid-19 do not attend the club.**

**If you have had contact with a family or household member who is unwell with the symptoms of Covid-19 do not attend the club for at least 14 days.**

**If you test positive for Covid-19 follow the Scottish Government Test & Protect Guidelines which was sent out to all Scottish households. A copy is also on the Club website.**

**Hobbs Cleaners are now back cleaning the club toilets / changing rooms & the field toilets on a Friday each week.**

**Apply current social distancing at all times during your visit to LESC.**

**Cover your mouth and nose when sneezing or coughing, and avoid touching your face, nose and eyes.**

**Club members and close family, social bubble, partners only at this stage **(no large groups of visitors).****

**If a club member requires a tent pitch, please contact the committee.**

**Club members travelling to the club should be aware that there is no changing or shower facilities available at this time.**



### **Arrival & parking:**

- **The gate must be closed & locked behind you when arriving & leaving the club.**
- **Be considerate when parking & apply social distancing.**
- **The club toilets are now in operation. We are operating a one person / 1 family or household at a time in the toilets during phase 3.**
- **Please follow instructions posted on the toilet doors. **Note: Changing & Showers remain closed.****
- **It is still recommended that you bring your own sanitizer etc.**
- **Overnight stay is allowed in your caravan with the use of club toilets.**
- **Anyone using chemical toilets must continue to empty them at home.**
- **Rubbish collections have re-started. Follow instructions on the bins.**

### **Caravan Toilets:**

- **Toilets are in use. Only one person / 1 family or household in the male & female toilets at a time.**
- **To help maintain this the doors should remain locked and not left with the catch on.**
- **Please wipe down surfaces you have used before & after use with the sanitizer provided.**
- ****Note: Changing & Showers remain closed.****

### Club Toilets:

- Toilets are in use. Only one person / 1 family or household in the male, female & disabled toilet at one time.
- Please wipe down surfaces you have used before & after use with the sanitizer provided.
- **Note: Changing & Showers remain closed.**

### Club House & Kitchen:

- **The club house, kitchen, training room upstairs & all fridges remain closed to members at this stage.**
- The freezer for cool box ice blocks is available in the open area between the changing rooms and clubhouse along with 240v sockets for using a personal cool box.

### Club Noticeboard area:

- Open for access to the roller shutter key for toilet, disabled toilet key, blue boat key, sail locker & fuel store.

### Workshop, Locker room, Lawnmower & RIB Shed:

- The workshop remains closed to members.
- Anyone requiring equipment from their lockers should access via a member of the committee. Equipment required for the remainder of the season should be stored in your boat, caravan or home.
- Lawnmower shed remains closed to members.

### Dinghy parks, Jetties & Slipways

- Apply current social distancing at all times.
- Be considerate when launching & recovering boats.

### **Blue Boat & Fuel Store:**

- Is now available for use. Key & fuel store key are hanging at the noticeboard area. Please return after use.

### **Race Hut:**

- Will be used in a reduced capacity as per the instructions on the fixture list & revised LESC Club racing procedures. Key is hanging at the notice board area. Wipes & bacterial spray are available inside the hut.

### **Restarting Sailing**

**As at all times sailing is conducted solely at the members own risk. LESC accepts no responsibility for the loss of life or injury to the members or others, or for the loss of, damage to, any vessels or equipment.**

- The blue diesel boat is now available.
- If Interested in using a Club Dinghy please contact Susan McGeorge who will allocate a boat for use.
- Individual private boat sailing is allowed.
- Buddy up with another helm as this is much safer than sailing alone.
- Two person dinghies and keelboats must be crewed according to current social distancing guidelines, same family or household.
- Social distancing whilst rigging, launching, and recovering must be observed.
