

## LESC Covid19 Risk Assessment August 2021

Due to the ongoing Covid19 pandemic this risk assessment is required to ensure that LESC remains mindful of the potential impact we could have on our members, other water users & the local community. The intent is to minimise risk by taking an extra conservative approach to our normal mode of operation at LESC.

This Risk Assessment will require regular review & must align with Scottish Government guidelines.

### Location

LESC Clubhouse, Caravan field, pontoons, grounds & on the water.

### Activity

General boating, caravan residency, picnicking, club racing & club run events.

### Issue

The current Covid19 pandemic is a rapidly evolving situation. It requires a high level of Social Distancing which will be required for some time to come, at the very least the entire 2020 sailing season. It is our responsibility as a sailing club to facilitate safe activity from our premises at LESC. This will rely on all members of LESC taking individual & collective responsibility.

4	Covid19 virus transmission. Social distancing difficult due to confined space.	Clubhouse toilets & changing rooms	H	Toilets and socially distanced changing allowed.	Toilet area 1 person / family at a time. Use sanitiser & cleaning products provided. Keep the area well ventilated. Showers remain closed.	L
5	Covid19 virus transmission. Social distancing is easy as it is designed for 1 person use only.	Disabled toilet & shower.	H	Toilets & shower allowed. Only 1 person / family at a time.	Always keep the area well ventilated. Clean before & after use using the cleaning products provided.	L
6	Covid19 virus transmission	Picnic benches.	M	Picnic tables are in use.	Use cleaning products provided.	L
7	Covid19 virus transmission	Club owned dinghies	M	Club dinghies available for member use.	Clean down boats prior & after use.	L

This is **your** evaluation of the potential impact and likelihood of harm occurring.

Risk rating	Action required
<p><b>High</b> For example,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>fatality possible to one or more individuals however infrequent</li> <li>major injury to few individuals occurring frequently</li> <li>likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting significant numbers of staff.</li> </ul>	Immediate action required.
<p><b>Medium</b> For example,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>major injury to one/few individuals occurring infrequently</li> <li>likelihood of long term muscular-skeletal problems affecting some staff.</li> </ul>	Requires attention as soon as possible.
<p><b>Low</b> For example, minor injury occurring infrequently to few staff.</p>	Not a priority, may need attention if not as low as reasonably practicable.
